AN OLD DOG SURVIVES SEPSIS

Gators Story - Submitted by Cindy Gimbel

The day began like any other normal Thursday in February. I got up early to feed the dogs and get things done around the house. Being RAW fed, my dogs act like they haven't eaten for weeks when it's meal time. Everyone including Gator our eldest bullmastiff ate breakfast like he hadn't seen food for days. Finishing our normal morning routine with a walk outside to potty, he got up on the couch for his much needed morning nap.

It was not unusual for Gator to continue resting on the couch in the dog room for a good part of the day, after all.....he was 11.5 years old. However, when it came time for supper, Gator showed no signs of being interested in his food bowl. Even after it was set in its usual spot on the floor he didn't move. He remained in the same spot on the couch, only sitting up and pinning his ears back. He followed the girls outside for the usual walk after supper but was anxious to come back in and spread himself out on the floor. By 10:00pm he had trouble standing. I was afraid of him not making it through the night.

By 8:00 am Friday morning we had him on a gurney type of blanket and rushed him to the clinic. On arrival his temperature was 105 with a heart rate of 150 beats per minute. At this point, unsure of his condition and over all situation Peter (our vet) conducted blood work, X-rays and an ultra sound. Not one of these tests indicated any abnormalities. As the afternoon progressed his temperature rose to 106 with a heart rate increase of 170. Mid day Peter called; Gator had been put on IV fluids with antibiotics. He was certain that Gator had gone septic. Peter assured me he would be in several times during the night although he did not give us much hope for Gator's survival. Gator was in critical condition and the odds were against him. Very few dogs manage to survive sepsis, and because of his Gator's age chance were more or less nil.

Saturday morning before leaving for the clinic to visit Gator, we called to see if he had managed to pull thru. It was a miracle; although still in critical condition, Gator had survived the night. Although he did not recognize us when we arrived his temperature had dropped overnight to 104 with a heart rate of 110. He was still being kept on IV fluids with antibiotics.

On our Sunday morning visit Gator raised his head, seemed brighter and recognized our voices.

Monday he showed interest in a few bites of cooked chicken. This was a huge improvement and a hopeful sign.

Peter called Tuesday morning; even though Gator had spent 5 days at the clinic on IV and was not completely out of the woods; he felt Gator would do better at home.

Gator continued to improve each day but we were fully aware that he could relapse at any time. For 4 continuous days he lay motionless on the floor with no desire to move. Each day he gave us very small indications that he was slightly improving. After almost a week, it was such a magnificent sight to see him get up off the floor on his own. It was almost 4 weeks later till we felt he was safe and no longer at risk for relapsing. Unfortunately he will never be his old self again.

What is Sepsis

Septicemia occurs when the persistent presence of bacterial organisms in a dog's bloodstream becomes systemic, meaning that it has spread throughout the body. This is also referred to as blood poisoning, and septic fever. This condition becomes very dangerous when it leads to abnormally low blood pressure and high body temperature, and can be fatal if left untreated. In severe cases, when the condition has progressed to septic shock, treatment alone will not be enough to save an animal.

Sepsis is a common cause of severe illness in dogs and in people that often proves to be fatal. It is a major cause of death in dogs and humans which can occur with the onset of infection or a traumatic injury. Death can come swiftly once sepsis sets in, often occurring within hours of the dog showing symptoms

Causes in detail

- *Septic shock or blood poisoning occurs when massive infection enters the blood. Dilation of blood vessels then occurs causing blood to pool in the tissues and not return to the heart for pumping.*
- *The leading cause of sepsis in dogs, originates in the GI tract.*
- *Canine parvoviral enteritis, is the most common cause of sepsis in dogs. Puppies and younger dogs are most likely to contract this condition*
- *Another cause of sepsis in dogs is the presence of pneumonia in the respiratory tract. Bacterial pneumonia can cause sepsis and death in dogs of all ages. This condition must be diagnosed and treated quickly to achieve the best outcome for the dog.*
- *Wounds that become infected are a cause of sepsis in dogs. This can include wounds from auto accidents or altercations with other animals.*
- *Diseases of the teeth and gums can cause sepsis. It is important to clean your dog's teeth on a regular basis to avoid this scenario.*

Symptoms

All forms of shock will generally lead to signs of profound weakness, cool skin temperature, pale gums and other mucus membranes, a rapid heart rate, rapid, shallow respiration, decreased mental responsiveness and a decrease in core body temperature. Dogs with septic shock may have a fever

- Typically, dogs will develop signs and symptoms of the disease in the gastrointestinal tract first
- Initial physical signs and symptoms typically include chills, fever, and lethargy
- Depression symptoms are common in dogs
- Tachycardia (rapid heart beat) and heart murmur are common

Identification

When a dog has an injury or infection, the immune system releases cells to sterilize the wound or combat infection. This can damage healthy tissues, which may become hot, red and inflamed. If the immune system in the dog is not up-to-par, sepsis can set in. Sepsis is difficult to diagnose early, and once the dog has symptoms, can turn into a life-threatening situation.

Treatment

Intravenous fluid therapy should be instituted in any dog suspected of having sepsis. The principal and most important aspects of treatment of a septic dog include drainage of the septic focus, appropriate antibiotic treatment and aggressive fluid therapy. Antibiotics need to be continued until the temperature and white blood cell count have returned to normal. Additional supportive care, including nutritional management, frequent reassessment and good nursing care are key aspects in the management of sepsis. Because bacterial translocation from the GI tract is a substantial concern, the early introduction of preferably enteral or, in dogs with vomiting, parenteral nutrition is paramount. Often these dogs require a feeding tube, and this measure should be taken as soon as possible in a hyporexic or anorexic dog. Finally, care should be taken to ensure adequate nursing care, including careful use of aseptic technique during catheter manipulation and frequent turning/movement of the afflicted dog.

Long Term Effects & Outcome

Septic shock could weaken the heart muscles, causing the dog not to tolerate the same amount of activity that he once could. Left untreated, shock leads to heart failure and death.

As I write this Gator celebrated his 13th Birthday June 25, 2010. He suffers from congestive heart failure but with medication it is being kept under control. He looks forward to his meals and still enjoys lying out in the sun for short periods of time. He enjoys life like any 13 year old Bullmastiff should. When he gets up and wanders to the door we jump and open the door. When he looks at us and cocks his head to the side, we jump and give him a cookie. Gator is a great ambassador for the Breed. As a puppy and his second show he won Best Puppy in Show. In 1991 at 2 years of age he was the #1 Bullmastiff in Canada in 1999. He took BOB over some of the best and finest bullmastiff in the ring at that time. He was also beaten by some of the best and finest. The ribbons and wins over the years are just icing on the cake, what makes this boy Special is that he is ours. We thank God every day for this boy, life with Gator has been an exciting journey.

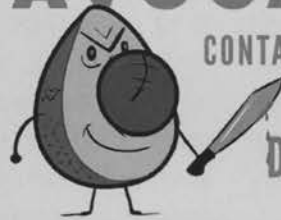

Ring Ready: If and When and Why Your Dog is a Show Dog

The Process as Defined by A Veteran Bitch, With Help From Friends

So you bought yourself a show puppy, did you? At least that is what “your breeder” says your puppy might be. We won’t go into all of the criteria for finding breeders, testing puppies, and investing in one of your own, will save those stories for some other times. You will thank me for that, because there is enough to be written and read on the topic of your show puppy. Let us start with a caution, and say that if you are embarking upon the sport of purebred dogs without being sure it is for you, without that certainty that comes immediately to some and never ignites for others, it might be wise to save yourself a great deal of time and stress and to write a generous check to your favorite charity (ABA Rescue would be my recommendation). There is no shame in acknowledging to yourself and admitting to breeders with whom you are in contact that you want a puppy and do not have an interest in showing dogs. However, if you chuckled at my warning, haven’t reached for your checkbook, and are still reading, still thinking that you want to enter the dog show world, now is as good a time as any to ask yourself, your breeder, and your puppy – do we really have what it takes to get ring ready? You can still change your mind, save face, save your money, and save yourself a potentially difficult discussion with your breeder now, before you embark on the process of preparing to show your dog, which begins with evaluating your puppy, progresses to training your dog, and culminates in presenting your (soon-to-be) champion.

Evaluating the Puppy

All puppies are cute. I know that people say that about human babies, but I think that Edward R. Murrow was more accurate when he opined that most infants look like Winston Churchill. Puppies, though, puppies are adorable, whether affenpinschers or Yorkshire terriers, or a mix of any of the breeds in between. Puppies tumble into our laps and possess our hearts. If you are looking for a show dog and do not feel something heart stirring when introduced to a pile of puppies, climb out of the whelping box, turn around, walk away, and pick another hobby. Perhaps you will find your bliss growing cacti for consumption. Harden your hearts, though, perspective show dog owners, because all cute puppies do not grow up to be excellent examples of the breed. Only a very few puppies should be chosen to become show dogs. **Remember, you want a show puppy!**

If you are buying a show prospect puppy, and do note that I have now inserted the word “prospect” into the phrase so as to begin explaining the selection process by focusing upon evaluating puppies and dogs, you will need to accept the possibility that the puppy you and your breeder choose for you may not grow up to be exactly what you want or what the breeder hopes, which is a show dog you can both exhibit proudly. So, we use the term “prospect” into the phrase so as to begin explaining the selection process by focusing upon evaluating puppies and dogs, you

will need to accept the possibility that the puppy you and your breeder choose for you may not grow up to be exactly what you want or what the breeder hopes, which is a show dog you can both exhibit proudly. So, we use the term “prospect” purposely, because anyone entering into the realm of dog breeding needs to know from the start that some puppies judged show worthy as youngsters do not fulfill those youthful promises. It is also true that some of the overlooked puppies in a litter may well become the better representatives of the breed at maturity. **Be prepared.**

This is one of the most difficult hurdles to be identified and defined right away, the concept of a “show prospect puppy.” It is tough for me to even type the phrase, however important I know it to be, let alone to explain to a new convert to the dog show world that, even though a particular puppy might have all of the necessary physical attributes important in a show dog, that puppy may not have a temperament suited to the show ring or that the puppy whose personality is perfectly suited to dog shows is less than an excellent example of correct conformation for the breed. You must prepare to make informed and intelligent choices based on the Bullmastiff Breed Standard and in tandem with the breeder you have chosen (referred to once the purchase is made as “your breeder,” quoted incessantly, and treated as royalty), perhaps turning away from the puppy who first got your attention with his antics or from the one sitting sweetly in the corner. Show prospect puppies are born, not made. It happens with some frequency and whether determined by breeder and/or by temperament tester (we love temperament testing to reinforce what we have determined about our puppies), that gorgeous puppy might be very noise sensitive or somewhat of a worrier, and neither of those two personalities are the best choice for someone seeking that special show dog. As well, the puppy who might possess all of the psychological ingredients of a show dog may be lacking in one or more critical conformation attributes. If you have chosen your breeder wisely, rely heavily on his or her judgement when it comes to that pile of puppies. Breeders all have their methods of evaluation and many have excellent success rates, but most know better than to guarantee that pretty puppy will be a show dog. There may come a time as your puppy grows, when you and your breeder will have to agree that your puppy is not going to grace the ring, has not grown up to be the show dog you both hoped he or she would. It happens and it is best for all parties to acknowledge the possibility and to plan for what will happen should that be the outcome. It can be daunting to begin the process, acknowledging all the while that this puppy, however much you love him or her, is not going to be your show dog.

Preparing the Show Dog

Let us assume, for purposes of this commentary, that your puppy has come home with you, been through the

usual puppy stages with no major problems, and is now deemed by your breeder and by you, the owner (that is your identifier in the dog world, from catalogs to conversations: "owner") to be worthy of the phrase show puppy. Notice that we have dropped the "prospect" and moved forward from evaluation to preparation. Congratulations, you own a show dog! Unless, that is, you have reconsidered, made your donation to ABA Rescue, and decided that you and your dog will stay home. If not, though, it is time to begin in earnest the preparation that goes into training a successful show dog.

Here, again, we make the assumption that your puppy is mentally and physically that puppy we all yearn for with each successful breeding, a show puppy. I will forgo the advice about socialization and training, all of which are covered in various articles and books, and all of which you will have been given by your breeder and followed exactly, I am sure. If you have a well-trained and socialized young dog, one with good conformation and a sound temperament, you are now ready to get your dog in the ring. You have a few critical decisions to make, all of which will impact your show experience as well as your dog's. You will need to decide what age your dog will enter the show ring. You must decide whether you will show your dog yourself and if not, who will. You will find yourself having to decide the extent to which you will dabble or immerse yourselves, you and your dog, in the show world. Will you go every weekend, travel great distances, invest in an RV, or will you show occasionally, keep your travels local, and find some dog friendly hotels. Your breeder, if you have chosen wisely, can serve as mentor here, too, can have input and opinions on all of the topics mentioned and can introduce you to possible handlers, to others "in the breed" and "in the fancy" (those who show dogs of the same breed as or show dogs of other breeds). As with choosing your breeder, choose your associations in the breed carefully, based not only on individuals' characters, but on their dogs and how they treat them, too. These people and dogs may end up as friends and advisors, even family of sorts, as you work on presenting your dog and others to come. Let's face the fact right now that most people do not stop at one show dog.

Now is the time to attend the handling classes organized by local dog clubs and kennel clubs. If you have never been to such a class, it might be a good idea to attend several classes "dogless" in order to have the opportunity to observe all that is expected of a show dog in the ring. Leave your show dog home while you learn what is expected of you and your dog when at class, so that you can teach him or her to gait properly, stand for the judge's examination, stand in a correct stack, accept a dental examination, respond to bait, and all of the behaviors a show dog needs to know. It may look like two minutes trotting around the ring, but there is more training involved than most people know. Do not be afraid to ask questions and gather information. Most classes are a mix of breeders who own and handle their own dogs, owners who handle their own dogs, and professional handlers who show dogs from several breeds and groups. If you are lucky, you can not only learn the ring procedures and

etiquette at handling class, but you can make acquaintances and contacts that will be valuable as you make decisions about your continuing involvement in dog showing.

Now is the time to learn the specifics of training and to become an expert at grooming, so that you can best prepare your show dog. Train your dog for the ring, certainly, but also teach yourself and your dog about the grooming requirements for your breed. Never put a dog in the ring who is not groomed properly and trained impeccably, as this will cast you, as owner, and your breeder in an unfavorable light with others in the sport. You did not come this far, literally or figuratively, to embarrass yourself or your mentor by exhibiting a dog unprepared for the ring. Certain exceptions can be made for unruly puppies, of course, and that bit of comic relief in the ring can be a well needed release of ringside tension with no aspersions cast on breeders, owners, or handlers. Puppies keep us all feeling like novices at some point. Be open to advice about grooming products, show clothes and leads, and training ideas, since there is no reason for you to start at the beginning when there are many great people in the sport who offer a wealth of experience and expertise. Since you have decided you want a show dog and your dog has been deemed worthy of that title, show dog, make the next decision to prepare properly, from grooming and training to presentation.

Presenting the (Soon-to-be) Champion

Who said that presentation is everything? While that may not be the case, exactly, if your puppy is correctly evaluated as a show puppy, has been prepared for the show ring properly, and is presented impeccably, you have already won. That may sound trite, but it is the truth. Dog shows today have evolved from earlier exhibitions of breeding stock that allowed breeders to view one another's animals and their get in order to make decisions about with whom they might work when making future plans for breeding programs. While you may not win points toward a championship or even win your class, every time you show, believe me when I note that your dog is being viewed by others in the fancy, those who know his or her sire and dam, grandparents, littermates, even distant ancestors. While we all show our dogs in hopes of winning, there are many reasons to exhibit your dogs and to take careful note of the other dogs of your breed in the ring. Your dog's competition for the points on any Saturday morning may well be his siblings, cousin or even an aunt or uncle. The sport of purebred dogs is truly a small world.

Since that is the case, since bullmastiff fanciers in California communicate regularly with those in the sport living in Maine, it is advisable to take presentation as seriously as we have evaluation and preparation. Your breeder may reside in Alaska, but rest assured that your puppy's ring debut will be reported to her by another veteran sitting ringside who knows him or her and your dog's pedigree much better than you do. Video may well make it to the breeder well before your victorious (or not) phone call. This is one more reason that presentation is so important. I would advise new owners to give careful consideration to who will show your dog.

Perhaps you will opt to do so yourself, earning a place dear to many of us as an owner handler. If so, be sure that you do that out of an honest desire to do so and in the belief that you can do a reasonable job presenting your dog in order to accentuate strengths. There is no shame in hiring a handler or having a friend show your dog. Some do not enjoy handling, others have physical limitations, and many know that they cannot do justice to their dog. If you fall into any of those categories, pay a professional and enjoy watching your dog be shown.

Being ringside while your dog is shown by someone you trust allows for valuable learning experiences for dog and owner, especially for those new to the sport. Nowhere else will you be able to view and even examine (always with permission and only after judging) other dogs of your breed. Since we all accept that there are no perfect dogs, let's assume that you have had several conversations with your breeder and others whose opinions you are growing to value about your dog's attributes and also about faults, that you have studied the Breed Standard, and are working on applying it to dogs you encounter. Remember that it is valuable to obtain some degree of objectivity in judging your dog and others, so that you will not succumb to kennel blindness and believe your animal superior to all others. Dog shows are great opportunities to see a number of dogs, to compare and contrast your dog with others, to apply the Breed Standard to all dogs and to judge dogs yourself.

It is only fair to all exhibitors that your dog and all of the others in the ring are presented as well as is possible, so whether you hire a handler or get in the ring with your dog, be sure that you or your handler have exercised and pottied your dog, obtained your armband, done any last minute grooming, and have bait at the ready. If you are handling, please ensure that you have reviewed ring procedure and watched the judge before your class is called, before your breed is even shown, if possible. Remember that this is a sport, one where courtesy, decorum, and sportsmanship are counted upon so that dogs and handlers all show their best selves in the ring. Every judge runs his or her ring a bit differently and you want to understand what will be asked of you and your dog. You might also notice how the judge interacts with dogs and handlers so that you are not surprised by instructions and interactions. Before you go in the ring, tell your dog that he or she is a winner, no matter what, and remember that what is equally as important as doing well is having fun! For the vast majority of us, this is a hobby, an avocation chosen out of our love of dogs! That would be this veteran's wish for all embarking on this sport: Have fun!

While it only lasts a few minutes, that first time in the ring, and seems to flash by like a bullmastiff in pursuit of an intruder, those fleeting moments are the beginning of your show dog's career! Yours, too, if you made your ring debut together. If you are very fortunate, years from now, you will be regaling someone visiting to look at puppies with the story of your first visit to your breeder, your first show dog, first dog show experience, maybe even your first litter. As I have noted before, some of those topics are best left to

be the subjects of forthcoming articles, but for now, let us remember what we have outlined herein. From evaluating puppies to preparing your dog, to exhibiting a show dog, you are now a member of a diverse and wonderful group, you are "in dogs." You may feel like a newcomer for quite a few years, and it is advisable to be humble in the face of the knowledge of others, but remember that every renowned judge, each famous handler, even your veteran breeder, all started with their first dog. Don't forget, along the way, as you gain experience and expertise, be kind to the next generation of fanciers. Share what you have learned and remind them all to have fun!

American Kennel Club NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLER SERIES

Did you know that more than 80% of show dogs are handled by their owners? To celebrate the dedication and enthusiasm of owner-handler exhibitors the American Kennel Club has created the new AKC National Owner-Handled Series. This non-titling competition will be held at select dog shows across the country.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC/Eukanuba show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Seven Foundations of a Successful Dog Breeder

Thoughts For the Dog Breeder

I – ENJOY YOUR DOGS

The primary reason anyone becomes involved with dog breeding and showing is a fundamental love of dogs. We treasure the companionship, the never failing loyalty, the delight they exude. We love to have them on our beds. Their eagerness to face the new day, even when we wake them up at dreadful hours, provides us a wonderment that brings back the exuberance of childhood. They forgive us when we lose our temper, when we are impatient, when we are far less than they are. They bring out the best of ourselves, they nurture the “big” us. Unfortunately, dog breeding and exhibiting can tempt our “little” selves. It can feed a fragile ego until it becomes a raging ego.

Often, this need to feel we are better than our fellow man is expressed in our possessions. We need to have the biggest winner, the producer of the most champions, the most champion puppies. We buy, we CO-own, we collect. Soon we have no time for dog pleasures, no time to play or rub a grateful belly, no time to stroke a patient brow. Soon we have no room for more dogs; we stack them and crate them and store them as though they were baubles that have no meaning but to make us feel important. We lose our ability to love.

Dog showing and breeding is a great vocation. It is creative and challenging and very rewarding. But we must never expect our hobby to take the place of a psychologist's work. We must never expect an unhealthy mental state to be cured by self-indulgence. Far too many people take to showing and breeding for the wrong reasons. Their houses go to ruin, their bank accounts evaporate, their credit hits the skids, their spouses and children are left to survive on their own as the breeder pursues their own manifestation of what they perceive to prove their self worth.

Being a dog breeder is a huge commitment. It means we should assign ourselves the role of lifetime student. It means we will be humbled in countless ways and in countless circumstances. It means our lessons will be of the hard knock variety if we are to truly learn them. It means frustration, long hours, late nights and early mornings. It means never getting to sleep-in again. It means finding friendships – some of which will last for a lifetime and some of which will founder, being built on social advantage. It means being quoted and misquoted and having words put in your mouth. It means being given ample opportunity to be as “small” as a human being can be. But, hopefully, it can provide an opportunity to learn to be “big”, to be generous, inquisitive, and adventurous. We should never ask ourselves if we are envied or important or successful. Those questions, are meaningless. At the end of the day, we should ask ourselves,

“Am I proud of the person I've become?” What we must always be are dog lovers. We must be their advocates. We must ensure the life of every dog we breed and every dog we own is fulfilled and an illustration of humanity at its finest hour. Our vanity must not be stroked by having our pictures in a magazine or seeing our name on some ranking system. Our self-worth must come from knowing we provide for our dogs a life of love, of pleasure, and of happiness.

II – BREED FOR IMPROVEMENT, NOT WINNERS

It is easy to become lost in the purpose of breeding quality dogs. For some, the attraction of the bright lights, the glamour and the glitz cause them to stray from the path.

Developing a bloodline that is well considered and that is a positive influence for the breed takes considerable discipline. Too often, the seemingly slow and carefully orchestrated effort to improve a breed is crossed up with the immediate desire to breed that one big winner and become famous.

The breeder's pledge must be to harbor and safeguard the breed. No breed is in perfect shape when the breeder happens upon it, and none shall be perfect when they lave. But to leave a breed in better shape than it was when you came upon it is the greatest compliment. To improve type, movement, temperament and health must be the bottom line for every committed breeder. Such accomplishment takes a long-range plan that is carefully thought through. It requires dedication and purpose. All too often, we are sidetracked by our desires to breed to the latest big winner, and then to the next and the next. Before long the pedigree is a long list of “who's who” that have no relationship to each other, other than they found success in the ring.

What is key to learn (and to believe) is success in the ring is not an automatic indication of the dog's true quality. We all wish one indicated the other but that is too easy. It would require the removal of human fallacy to be accomplished! Dogs do not excel for all the same reasons. Consequently, you can't simply breed one big winner to another and produce more big winners. Every feature and their nature of inheritance must be studied and understood before you can “manage” the inheritance variables. Once you gain this skill, you are on the road to producing a line of winners.

III – TO THINE OWN SELF BE TRUE

The breeding of fine purebred dogs should be considered the pursuit of perfection – it is not the maintenance of it. All dogs have faults, all dogs are less than ideal in some ways and areas.

If not, the “ideal” has not been well enough conceived. It is very easy to fall into the trap of being defensive about one’s own dogs. This usually happens because what we assume to be correct is challenged by another as being less so. This disharmony causes confusion in our mind and ultimately unhappiness. To right ourselves, we often become defensive and try to rid ourselves of that which is causing us the discomfort –namely the opinion that does not compliment our own.

We must realize that “truth” is the ultimate standard by which our decisions should be made. In most cases, a roached back is a roached back, whether we choose to recognize it as such or not. Consequently, the best way for us to not be put into a position of being unhappily surprised is to pursue knowledge relentlessly to ensure our opinion is as accurate and close to the “truth” as possible. This knowledge is gained in many ways, one of which is learning from fellow breeders. We must fight the urge to make up our minds about something and refuse to consider another viewpoint. Indeed, we do not make decisions based on facts when we are first learning, we are depending upon what we perceive to be the expertise of others to provide that for us. If that so-called expertise is, in fact, faulty, our whole knowledge base is called into question. And that causes us great anxiety. The best place to sit is in the seat of the knowledge seeker. Whenever provided with an opinion that is different than the one you currently hold, always seek to understand the viewpoint of the other. Why does the person perceive something differently than you? Understanding another’s point of view can be the road to greater knowledge, if you shut that door and do not entertain the prospect of learning something different than what you think is truth you will never actually recognize the truth and you will not succeed in your goal. Quite honestly, you should be more critical of your dogs than anyone else could possibly be. That is not to say you should attribute faults to your dogs they do not possess, but your evaluation must be as detailed as possible and you must strive to see clearly their true faults and virtues. From this comes the map to success.

IV – DEAL WITH OTHERS AS YOU WOULD HAVE THEM DEAL WITH YOU

Sounds a bit like the golden rule that we learn in childhood. Yet it is amazing how many people forget this very important axiom. In dealing with others, regardless of the matter, think always of the other person’s position. I have heard repeatedly, people state how they were burned in a CO-ownership agreement. All too often the agreement is geared toward benefiting one part (often the seller) over another. Written agreements somehow are tainted as being only needed in a contentious situation. This is the first misconception.

Not having a written agreement should be the very rare exception, not the reverse. Too often, should a worthwhile puppy be produced from one of these undefined arrangements, the fight is on for possession. Before contemplating selling a dog on a

co-ownership or leasing it or offering stud service for a puppy back, you should think through what exactly you expect and desire from such an arrangement. Too often, these business dealings occur in the spur of the moment during a telephone conversation, and the deal is struck before either party has really had an opportunity to think it through. For some reason, rather than rethinking the situation, we tend to try to follow through on such an ill-conceived arrangement only to end up bitter enemies in the end.

If people would stop and think about the likely end result, they would realize the best possible thing to protect the friendship is to have a written understanding. It is very rare a litter is going to have more than one star if any at all. Consequently, it is important to understand who is going to own that super puppy, should it appear. People are too willing to tear apart relationships should one person seem to benefit a bit more than another. This is too sad and is reflective of the self-benefit motivation that all too many find as the driving force for their actions. When pressed, it is far better to give than to receive. It is far better to let the other seemingly benefit than to destroy a relationship and acquire the reputation of being disreputable and self centered, if for no other reason than it makes you grow as a human being, which is probably a fair trade off in the long run.

V – BY GIVING YOU HAVE NOTHING TO LOSE

Another pitfall breeders often experience is the inability to celebrate other’s successes. While certainly we feel the route we are taking is the best way to approach that utopian plateau of breed perfection, there are actually many routes to that same goal. It takes nothing at all away from our own accomplishments to recognize the accomplished efforts of other breeders. This inability and unwillingness to appreciate other’s efforts usually comes from having made a decision not to breed to certain bloodlines or deal with certain persons. When such a kennel then produces a success, it is difficult for us to acknowledge such an achievement for we tend to find that inconsistent with our opinion of that particular person or family of dogs. It takes quite an honest and secure person to recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of others. While it is probably good advice to hold our criticisms closer to our chest, recognizing another’s achievement only brings good things. By being someone who can see the virtues in breeding lines other than your own, you gain a reputation of fairness and objectivity that is a very rare pearl in dogdom.

You may find, over time, your point of view and your philosophies are taken with much greater weight when others do not perceive them to have originated in a mind consumed with self-aggrandizement. Thus, by doing so you lose nothing and yet you gain so very much.

VI – MAKE USE OF OTHER’S ACHIEVEMENTS

One of the worst situations a breeder can find her/himself

in is to partition themselves off from another kennel or bloodline. It is highly unlikely that all improvements toward the perfection of a breed are going to come from one single kennel or bloodline. Like flowers in the field, they will spring up in various places. The clever breeder is the one who knows how to pick from all the field those who will make the ultimate, sublime bouquet. And to do this, you must be able to use the strengths of other kennels and bloodlines.

Breeders will tend to have certain biases; and quite honestly, there are certain strengths and weaknesses in most bloodlines. While you may feel you have achieved the highest ground in certain areas, there will doubtless be other areas in which your dogs and bloodlines are less strong than others. Not to recognize this fact is to ensure you will plateau quite early in your breeding career. And by that I mean you will stabilize and go no further. You must always keep a watchful eye for that very special bloom that will enhance your bouquet. It is this sophisticated combining of families without losing the good points of your own bloodline that strengthen a kennel and move it forward in breed importance. It takes careful consideration, orchestration and pruning to come to fruition.

VII – YOU ARE ONLY AS GOOD AS YOUR MORALS

My last axiom addresses the whole truth of morality. It has many facets and many ways of expressing itself. Spreading rumors, the accuracy of which might be doubtful, is one very good example. Selling dogs on Co-ownerships as a means to control other breeders is certainly another. Accusing other lines of genetic problems while being less than entirely honest about your own is yet another. In all, it goes to the very core of who we are. Do we know right from wrong? Do we practice right in all circumstances?

Dog breeding is not about that one great win or that one great winner, it is about breed improvement over time, it is about protecting a breed.

Too many people are in search of some kind of sign of their self worth and they think they will obtain some special level of respect and honor if they have a big winner. Dog breeding is a lifetime's work. It is a continuum which no matter how quickly you want to "put yourself on the map", you will ultimately be a reflection of your true character. To wit, you can't fool all of the people all of the time. There is no honor in "adjusting" reality to give you the appearance of achieving something you do not have.

Politicking for wins will not make your dogs any better than they are. Faking your dogs will not make them any better than they are. You may think you can fool the world, but you will ultimately pay the price. No one wants to be a pretender. And yet, some of the worst pretenders are people who seem to be

infatuated with spreading rumors about other people and dogs. These people live in glass houses and invariably they know it.

The breeding of dogs is not about how you impress the neighbors, your peers or anyone else. It is the expression of your love of dogs and your personal pursuit in creating an art.

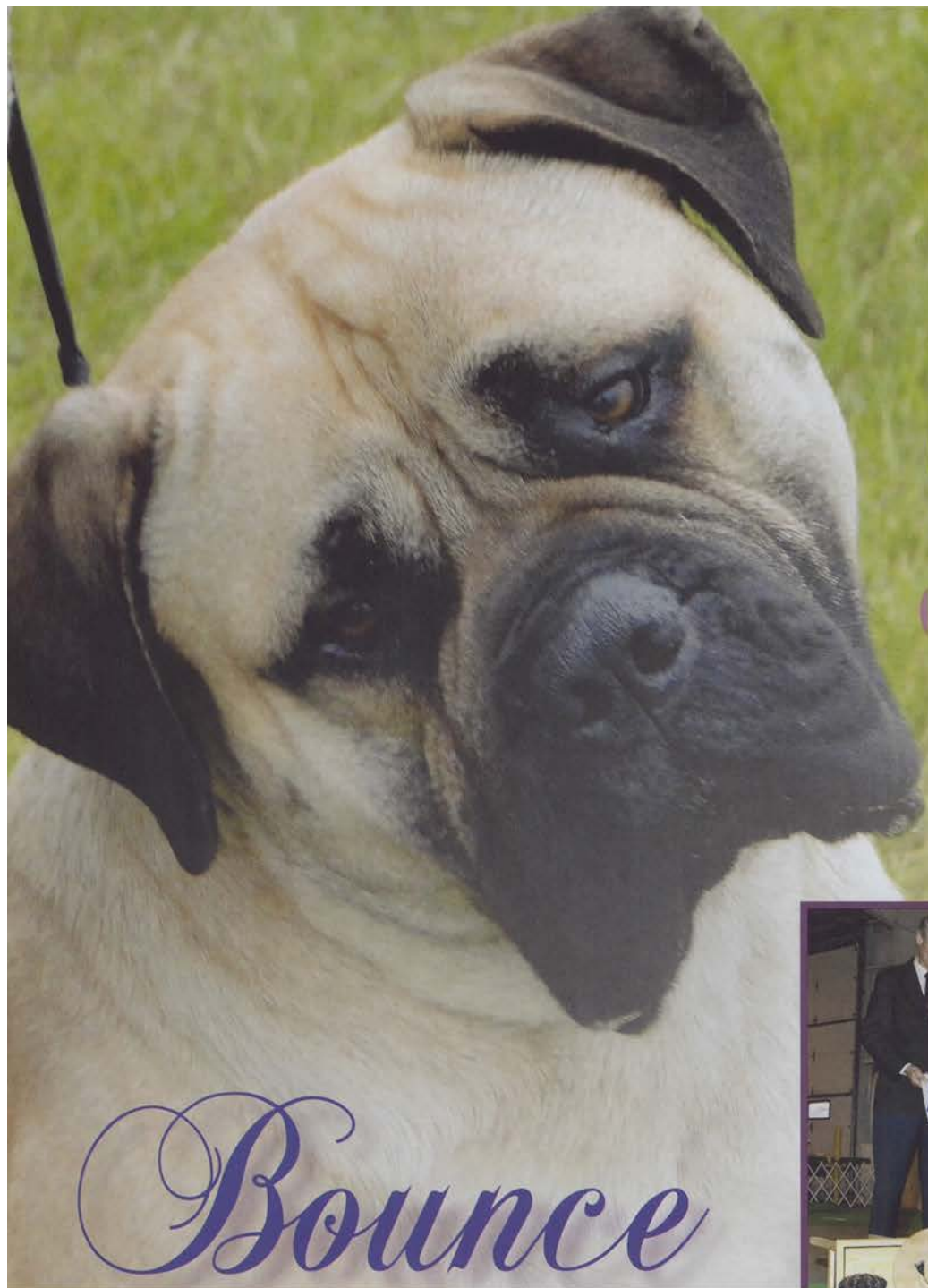
You cannot lie about the art you create; you cannot lie to yourself. While this list, I am quite sure, sounds like a sermon from the mount, it encompasses the many pitfalls that we dog breeders face every day. Some of us are equipped to navigate them. We are all tested from time to time, even the most educated, psychologically balanced, intelligent and honest amongst us. There are times when it feels much better to zing someone who has been hurtful, to control those whom we feel do not have the proper motivation, to become the ones who attract the adulation. Only through careful thought and well-considered action can we hope to become better people and therefore better dog breeders.

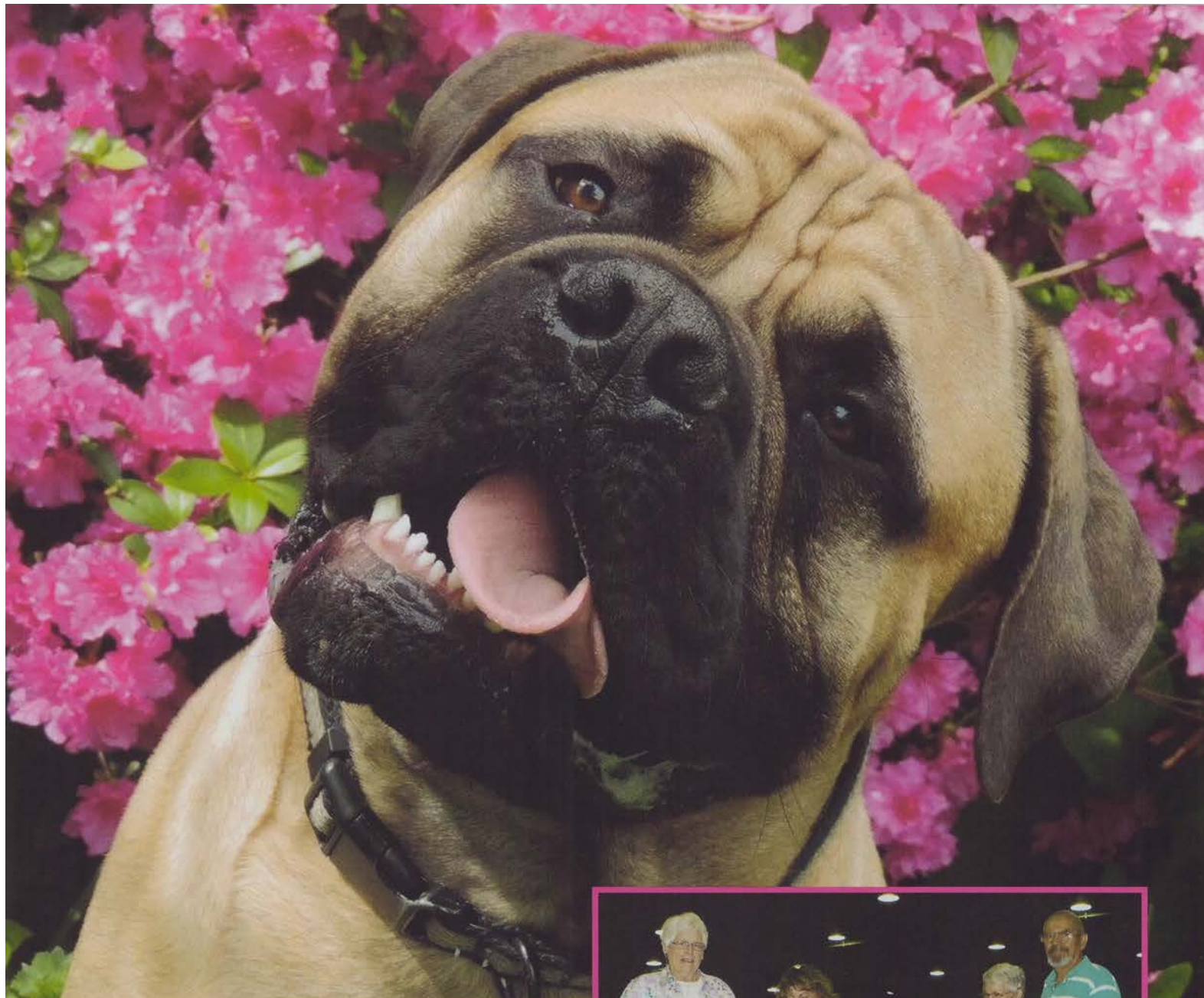

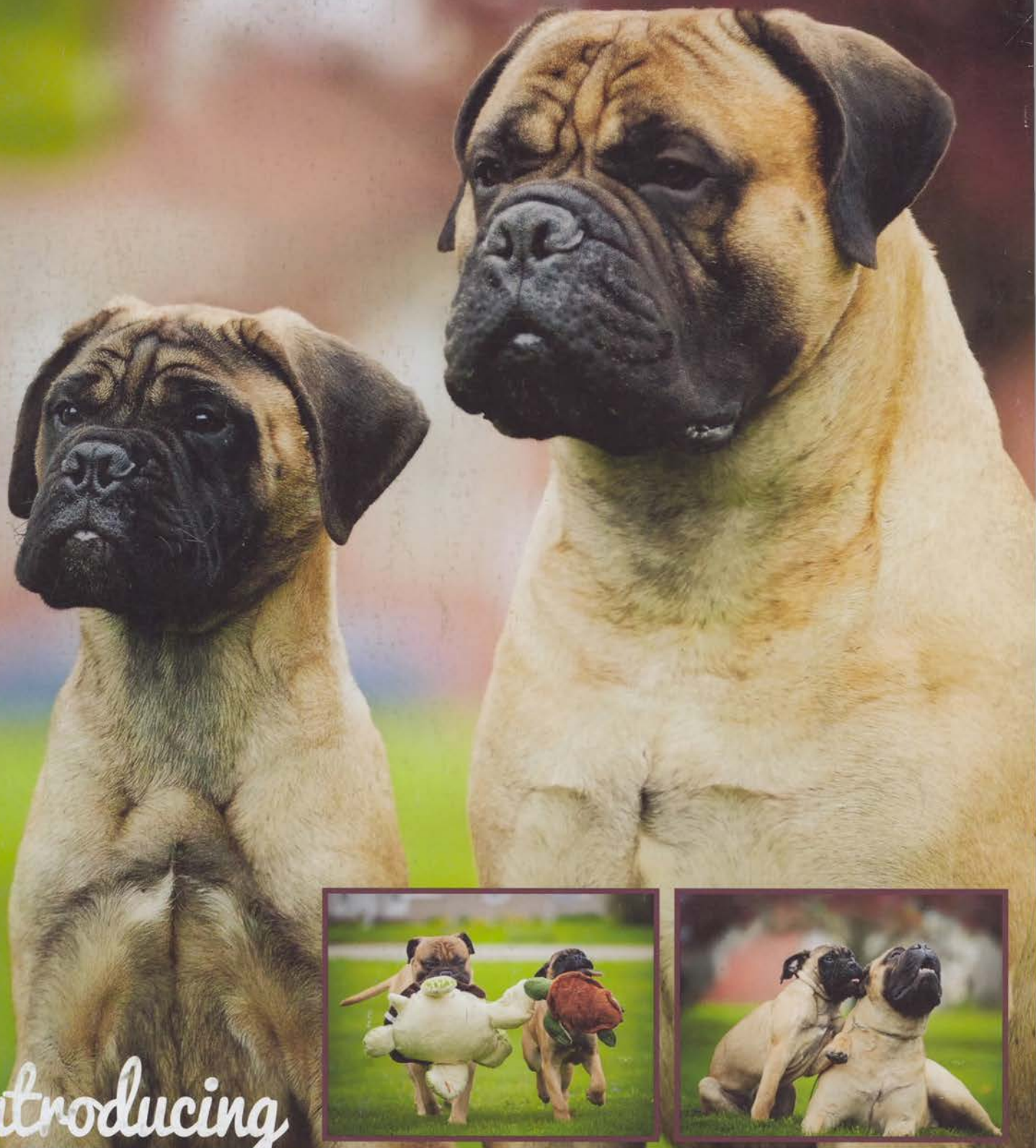
