Kimber is the youngest bullmastiff to achieve the AKC VCD1 title (Versatile Companion Dog 1) which requires the CD (Novice Obedience), Novice Agility titles (Standard and JWW) and a Tracking title (TD or TDU).

Kimber achieved these titles in a span of less than 3 months from April - June 2017 and completed the VCD1 at 17 months of age.

Kimber has qualified for the AKC 2018 Rally Nationals in the Rally Advanced Class and participates in a wide variety of other AKC sanctioned events. She is ranked as the fastest bullmastiff in Fast CAT and is a certified TDI therapy dog.

She is the perfect mixture of beauty and brains and I am so thankful to Kim Cook for picking her for me. I am looking forward to the future with this gorgeous red girl. We plan on continuing to achieve in tracking, obedience, agility and conformation.



Marilyn Cather was involved in the Bullmastiff breed for almost 50 years, acquiring her first in the mid-60s. Her love for showing, breeding and companionship with these marvelous dogs never wavered during that time and she cultivated that same interest in her granddaughter, Sara Patchen.

Known affectionately as "Grandma" to all who knew her, Marilyn and her husband, Chuck christened their breeding and showing program as Catherwood. They successfully campaigned a lew specials and had a handful of litters, never in quantity, concentrating on health and soundness of temperament foremost. Marilyn's last litter was co-bred with Sara and although she was never able to see the puppies grow and mature, she was very aware and proud of them.

Her involvement and admiration of the breed took her to faraway places such as Norway, England and Scotland as well as attending national specialties in all parts of the country. A quiet contributor, Marilyn was proud to mentor Sara as her successor beginning very early in childhood. It was common place to see Sara attend national and regional specialties with her grandmother, eventually handling, caring and partnering with her to carry on the Catherwood banner. Nothing made Marilyn more proud than to see Sara in the ring with one of her dogs who was a companion first and show dog last.

When her last Bullmastiff passed away, a very special gift was given to her by Cathe Crislip, her beloved Beezie. Marilyn considered Beezie her best friend and Beezie returned the honor. There are no words that would describe how happy Beezie made Marilyn every day, as her friend and constant companion.

Countless memories could be shared about Marilyn, her love for driving (with a very heavy foot and chirping radar detector), eating her favorite seafood of scallops, drinking merlot with a good meal and having a sweet dessert afterwards. Her favorite flower was pansies and she loved the various hues of purple that brightened her garden, bringing her much pleasure. Marilyn enjoyed attending the national specialty every year, visiting with friends, seeing all of the dogs and watching Sara handle.

Marilyn loved her profession as a registered nurse and her family. She was courageous and long-suffering when arthritis and a weakening heart challenged her declining health. What a treasure she was to all of us who knew her and considered her as a friend.

We were so lucky to have had her longer than what was predicted by the doctors and are left with good memories to ease our heartache.

Ronin's quality was evident even as a very young puppy. His exceptional bone, substance and headpiece were evident at birth. Ronin (or "purple boy" as he was then known) became selected for the VanDenburgs based on his bulletproof temperament. He has been a correct Bullmastiff and loyal family dog since the day he left dal Primo to start his life in Tennessee.

Ronin quickly began turning heads and had a very successful career as a young dog. He was breeder owner handled to a 5 point major at the 2012 Eukanuba AKC National Championships under Ann Ingram of Ireland and finished two months later at his next show in Indianapolis, Indiana handled by Katie Martin. Soon after professional handler, Jamie Clute took the lead, and at just 15 months old, our Samurai won the 2013 SEBA specialty under breeder Judge Barbara Heck, and Ronin repeated this win at the 2015 SEBA specialty, winning back-to-back group ones that same weekend. A month later, Ronin and Jamie achieved Best in Show in stellar competition at the 2015 Greater Houston Working Dog Club in Houston Texas! Together Ronin and Jamie have attained multiple breeds, group wins and placements finishing 2015 the #3 Bullmastiff in the breed in very limited showing.

In 2016 Ronin traveled to New York City and became dal Primo's first Westminister Kennel Club Best of Breed winner, he later went on that evening to hit the green carpet at Madison Square Garden and made the cut in an incredible Working Group!

Ronin capped off 2016 by achieving the ultimate goal of any person who values the sport of showing dogs; Best of Breed at the American Bullmastiff Association National Specialty. Ronin was brought to this show in the very best possible condition and was presented flawlessly by his handler and friend Jamie Clute. It was immediately evident this was his year to shine, and that he did. Our most heartfelt gratitude to Judge Judith Daniels for this prestigious win.

Ronin stands at the top of the Bullmastiff standard, has exceptional bone, beautiful breed type, and is properly balanced. In addition to being handsome Ronin is Penn Hip Certified, OFA cleared elbows and has a Board Certified Cardiologist -Echocardiogram certified heart. His correct, rock-solid temperament still stands as one of his best qualities and has enabled him to be a Lazy-Boy chair hogging house pet one weekend, and a champion show dog the next.

Ronin resides in Chattanooga TN and lives with his owners, George, Laura and Kyle VanDenburg and his niece, Willow. Who are grateful for the opportunity bestowed upon us with the trust and honor of owning such a fabulous breed specimen, and all he was destined to accomplish. Ronin has been a classic warrior and achieved ten-fold his Samurai spirit. Special thanks to every person who was involved in Ronin being to be the amazing dog he is today, and to all the judges who recognized his quality over the last five years. American Bullmastiff Association Health & Research Report

Renal Dysplasia in the Bullmastiff

The Health and Research Committee of the American Bullmastiff Association has been working with the American Kennel Club Canine Health Foundation to obtain information regarding the term "Renal Dysplasia". As you may know, there has been a lot of discussion regarding this condition. The goal of this committee is to provide accurate and scientific information as opposed to possible misinformation.

First we must define renal dysplasia. There is genetic renal dysplasia (usually noted as juvenile nephropathy) and is usually identified in young/juvenile dogs. Tissue biopsy is required to determine the cause of the disease. For clarity, this is what is considered genetic induced renal dysplasia as opposed to renal dysplasia caused by other factors. The kidneys are a complex organ. Its primary function is to filter out all impurities. One must remember that the kidneys can be affected by connecting structures such as the ureter and bladder. Infections (such as leptospirosis, lyme disease, pyelonephritis), exposure to toxins, inoculations, auto-immune disease and neoplasms can all have an affect in the urinary tract which can migrate, interfere with or originate in the kidney. These conditions can affect the kidney causing "renal dysplasia" but it is not the genetic type.

For clarification, the renal dyplasia discussed herein is that of a genetic nature.

To date, there has been a very small sample in Bullmastiffs as opposed to other breeds. Whereas over 100 Labrador Retrievers have been examined, only a total of 5 Bullmastiffs have been examined according to the International Veterinary Renal Pathology Service.

The difficulty is that lesions consistent with renal dysplasia have not been positively identified as to a genetic/heritable disease. Because canine kidneys continue to develop after birth, it is entirely possible that these dogs were exposed to a toxin or virus in utero or shortly after birth. These types of insults can stop growth of the kidneys and result in kidneys that look very familiar to genetically induced renal dysplasia.

What are the symptoms of genetic renal dysplasia?

The initial signs are typically increased thirst, drinking, and urination. The urine is usually very dilute. As the disease progresses, signs such as decreased appetite and activity, poor body condition, vomiting and bad breath can occur. Blood values would indicate an increased serum creatinine and there may also blood and protein in the urine.

How do we diagnose genetic renal dysplasia?

As stated above, tissue biopsy is the only reliable test at this time. Tests to rule out other factors must also be explored.

Is this an inherited disease?

At this time, there is no scientific evidence that has reported a specific gene that causes this. This is not to say it does not exist. There have been other breeds that have been identified but whether or not it is the same gene is unknown.

What is the mode of inheritance for genetic renal dysplasia?

There is no known genetic basis for bullmastiff renal dysplasia and no peer-reviewed scientific literature that has reported the gene. Therefore mode of inheritance and similarity or difference to other breeds cannot be determined.

Can I do anything to prevent this?

Genetic induced renal dysplasia "usually" affects young dogs. However, an older dog may develop some form of kidney disease later in life. Yearly blood panels (CBC, BUN, Creatinine levels) can indicate if there is a decline in kidney function. Diet, medication and vigilance can give your dog a good quality of life.

Is there a reliable test?

Currently, no. Until we find a way it is inherited and the research to identify it we need to be aware and take all factors into consideration, particularly when it comes to breeding. There has been some talk regarding the DogGenes test but it has not been appropriately validated. Some of the methods and materials used are questionable. For further information please check out the following:

The take away from all this is that more research is needed. If you have had the misfortune of having a dog succumb to genetic induced renal dysplasia, a tissue sample is vital to help determine if there is indeed any genetic correspondence. Sub Aortic Stenosis (SAS) in the Bullmastiff

The American Bullmastiff Association has been participating in a research study probing the incidence and inheritance of Sub-Aortic Stenosis (SAS) in our breed. Aortic stenosis is one of the most prevalent, congenital cardiac diseases in dogs. It is characterized by an obstruction (stenosis) near the aortic valve, which causes turbulence in the blood as it passes through the valve, manifested in most affected dogs as a heart murmur. The location of the obstruction can be in the valve, above the valve, or below the valve which is the most prevalent (sub-aortic) or SAS.

SAS can be in a mild form, moderate form and severe form. Those with a mild or even moderate form usually will lead a full life of normal duration and quality and more than likely be asymptomatic (shows no evidence of disease). Dogs with a severe form of SAS are at risk of sudden death. Electrocardiograms are not a diagnostic tool and in many cases appear normal. Auscultation (listening with a stethoscope) can detect a murmur but not SAS. A Doppler Echocardiogram will show the presence of lesions and an increased velocity in the flow of blood across the aortic valve due to the constriction of the valve by the lesion. A Doppler Echo will also show aortic regurgitation in a high percentage of SAS cases. The lesions described are not present at birth but may first occur until around the age of 3 to 4 weeks. The resulting heart murmur may not be detected until around the age of 6 to 8 weeks. It is not unusual to hear a heart murmur in a puppy that is completely innocent and disappear as the puppy matures. If the murmur is still present past 16 weeks of age, it may indicate a problem.

This is an inherited disease. What is not known is the mode of inheritance. The opinion is that this is a dominant trait with incomplete penetrance. In simple English, this means that although the trait is dominant, the trait is not passed on to all offspring. SAS is also believed to be polygenic i.e.: determined by several different genes.

Due to these factors, identifying inheritance is very complex. What can be taken away from this is: Any affected dog can produce SAS in its offspring. It does not need to come from both parents. A clinical unaffected dog may carry the gene onto its offspring.

The American Bullmastiff Association is participating in a clinical research study at this time to hopefully find a DNA test to determine mode of inheritance. We are fortunate to have one of the country's leading cardiologists (Dr. Joshua Stern, PhD, DVM ACVIM) conduct this study. The findings are categorized as such:

1. Affected – Doppler velocity of 2.5 or higher - Affected dogs should not be used in any breeding program. There may or may not be structural changes present.

2. Equivocal – Soft murmur with Doppler velocity of 2.0 to 2.5 – this is often the case more than not and needs careful screening. An equivocal dog may have a soft murmur at rest or a mild increase in intensity with exercise. Structural changes to the heart would lead to not using this dog in a breeding program. If no structural changes are evident, these dogs MAY be used in a breeding program but there is a RISK involved. These dogs should be bred to unaffected dogs.

3. Unaffected – No detectable murmur and flow velocity of 2.0 or below.

TESTING: There have been some incidences of SAS with no murmur present which indicates that auscultation is not a reliable tool to rule out the disease. The gold standard is a cardiac echo Doppler study. This must be performed by a board certified cardiologist.

There have been some instances where a dog may have "passed" with one echo cardiogram and failed at another. So how do you know if the information you are receiving is accurate? There are several factors: the experience and knowledge of the cardiologist, the equipment being used, and the approach taken when performing the exam. Due to these many factors, it may put in question the validity of the results. The availability of qualified individuals is not always easy to come by. So what can you as a breeder/owner do to ensure that the test being performed will give you the proper information to determine whether or not your dog indeed has SAS or not? With that being said, not everyone has the opportunity to have their dog examined by such an authority as Dr. Stern. His experience, knowledge and expertise are without question.

While there are other factors that may affect results, there is one tool that can be used to provide more accuracy in testing for SAS.

At the end of this article there is a web address to download and print the submission form that your Veterinary Cardiologist needs to complete. This form ensures that all dogs examined, no matter where, will have uniform data and measurements that will ultimately assist Dr. Stern with his study. You may state that our breed is in a study by Dr. Stern to determine a mode of inheritance for the SAS gene and further development of a blood test to determine such a gene. There is overwhelming evidence that this condition is prevalent in our breed. The statistics thus far has shown that 2 out of 10 dogs are affected, meaning evidence of SAS. 5 out of 10 dogs are equivocal. 3 out of 10 are normal and not affected. That is an astonishing 7 out of 10 that are affected or equivocal. Since this is an inherited disease, screening is vital to any breeding program. Any dog can pass it on regardless of his/her "normal" results if that gene is present.

Please support the ABA Health and Research team in participating in our Cardiac Clinic opportunities. It is a fervent goal to identify that gene and hopefully come up with a test for it. That is why ongoing research is vital to preserve and protect our breed.

Juniors Are the Future

It was several years ago when my daughter became interested in showing our Bullmastiffs that I found that there was a program in AKC for our youth to benefit by competing in the Juniors ring. I was already very involved with my two children who showed horses and then added the sport of dogs to our growing list of interests. Through the 4-H program and the extension agency of our county many of our 4-H kids in our club were encouraged to compete at the AKC level to encourage their growing interest. 4-H is a wonderful program to teach children the proper care, management and training of a dog. However, we found that junior competition at the AKC level really put the finishing touches on our club member's showmanship.

I found many children to have a mild interest in learning everything they could about handing and training a dog. What really became exciting was finding the diamond in the group that was so rough on first impression. Then that child would be the one in the group that would actually work with their dog during the week and show immense improvement over the 7 days between meetings.

Unfortunately, many of these children so driven did not have the financial ability to compete in AKC events or to obtain a purebred dog to move forward with. All the children that we have worked with over the years that have had the drive to compete and qualify to go to Royal Canin or Westminster, we have made sure that they have been able to go and give it a try.

Diversity has been found to decrease risk of genetic disorders, some autoimmune diseases, and puppy mortality, while being correlated with longer life expectancy and larger litter sizes, so it is an important consideration in breeding. Because every puppy within a litter inherits a unique combination of DNA from its ancestors, genetic tests of diversity appear likely to be more sensitive measurements than paper calculations, such as coefficient of inbreeding scores, which assume all puppies are identical.



After testing, a breeder can then apply her dog's genetic diversity, trait and disorder results by using the included Breeder Tool, which allows breeders to digitally compare other tested Bullmastiffs from around the world to plan litters of puppies that are projected to be the most genetically healthy and diverse.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

• Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.

• Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.

• Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.

• The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.

• The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.

• The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.

• The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.

• The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.

• Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.

• Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.

Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.

• Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.

• Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.

Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.

• Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

The Veteran Bitch on Sportsmanship

Recently, this Veteran Bitch turned to the Oxford English Dictionary for an explanation of sportsmanship. Defined as "fair and generous behavior or treatment of others, especially in a sporting contest," it sounds so simple and straightforward. From what I have observed ringside, most of us in the dog show world like to think ourselves good sports, but the truth is that some of us fall far short of personifying the definition. We can all agree that when there are people involved, the individual politics, philosophies, and personalities complicate any sport.

The powers that be at AKC have learned the lesson that the concept of sportsmanship needs defining and fostering and have provided all of us in the fancy with the AKC Code of Sportsmanship. It is included here for the perusal of some and for further study by others. The question is whether this or any codified list of behaviors goes anywhere near solving the issues. This might be one more instance when we need to go beyond thoughts on the topic, beyond theory, and look at actions and words. Putting sportsmanship on paper and putting it into practice appear to be very different things.

At a dog show on any given weekend, most of us, from veterans to newbies, are talking dogs, judging toplines, critiquing movement, discussing temperaments, noting headpieces. As the discussions continue, eavesdroppers might hear everything from comments on tight cat feet to questions on correct tail sets. Our Breed Standard covers it all and we strive to apply the two-dimensional description on paper to three-dimensional dogs in motion. As with the concept of sportsmanship, the standard sounds straightforward in theory, but is much more complicated when in practice. There are as many interpretations and opinions as there are breeders.

Maybe it is time to remember what the sport is about, as AKC reminds up in the AKC Code of Sportsmanship: It is all about the dogs! When we look to the dogs, we look away from the ego and greed that result in poor sportsmanship. We all know, whether we present our dogs in the conformation ring or compete in any of the performance events, the dogs are the true athletes. It looks to this Veteran Bitch as though they are also the natural sportsmen:

- Dogs give their all.
- Dogs are honest.
- Dogs are dedicated.
- Dogs are grateful.
- Dogs are loyal.
- Dogs are forgiving.





Roomba – Optimus has learned to deal with anything.

He doesn't climb on furniture (even when invited on the couch he doesn't jump up because he's not experienced this luxury before). Optimus is gentle enough for a 5-year-old boy to walk and allows toys to be marched up and down his back. He loves sleeping upside down and very much wants to be near his people – without being all over you or climbing into your lap. He's respectful of people, loves pets, is non-destructive, housebroken, easy to bathe, doesn't mind his nails clipped, doesn't guard his food and likes to keep an eye on his house and his people.

Optimus is probably around 5 years old, and weighs about 105 pounds. He's likely to always have some bald spots on his rear end but is a gorgeous deep red boy. He's calm, kind, and trustworthy. 

The Nose Knows

--an Introduction to Scent Work, AKC STYLE By Kathleen White and Arlene King

A litter of puppies is born. Their eyes are closed, they can't hear and they are dependent for everything, but even when first born, no one has to guide them to "Mom" to eat. A puppy is born with an amazing scenting ability that will last their entire life. On October 1, 2017 AKC will launch a new performance event: Canine Scent Work. This is a fun and worthwhile activity that dogs love because it showcases their natural ability and is well worth the time and energy it will take to learn the rules and regulations (all 78 pages!).

Scent Work utilizes the dog's keen, innate sense of smell to detect known, hidden scents (essential oils) and communicate the scent's location to the handler. The dog's "alert" can be a variety of behaviors: putting a paw on the scent, a sit, a down, barking, pointing, a neck snap, a look at the handler, etc. As the team progresses in Scent Work, the challenges increase with a variety of environments and conditions and more difficult hides.

The titling levels are Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master in each environment. Dogs begin with the Novice level and move up as they earn titles. Three successful searches are required to earn a title and if a dog qualifies ten times they earn the Elite title for that environment. When a dog has achieved a Master title in one of the environments they can enter the Detective class which involves all the scents and environments and the dog can need to find up to ten hides.

The environment is also known as an "element" and are: (1) containers; (2) interior; (3) exterior; and (4) buried. A title is offered for each of these classes (for example, Novice Containers earns the Scent Work Container Novice Title or SCN). When all four elements are completed the dog will earn an overall working level title: Novice Containers (SCN) plus Novice Interior (SIN) plus Novice Exterior (SEN) plus Novice Buried (SBN) equal the overall Novice Scent Work Title (SWN).

A dog may progress through the elements at different speeds; for example, a dog may be entered in advanced container class and novice exterior class in the same trial. Exhibitors quickly learn that they need to keep track as to what levels their dog(s) are working at in each element.

The target odors or "hides" are Birch (Betula lenta), Anise (Pimpinella anisum), Clove (Eugenia caryophyllata) and Cypress (Cupressus sempevirens). Birch is the target odor for Novice (dog must find 1 hide); Birch and/or Anise may be used in Advanced (dog must find 2 hides); Birch and/or Anise and/or Clove may be utilized in Excellent (dog must find 3 hides); Birch and/or Anise and/or Clove and/or Cypress in Master (dog must find 1 to 3 hides, exhibitor will not know how many hides there are).

The target odors or "hides" are Birch (Betula lenta), Anise (Pimpinella anisum), Clove (Eugenia caryophyllata) and Cypress (Cupressus sempevirens). Birch is the target odor for Novice (dog must find 1 hide); Birch and/or Anise may be used in Advanced (dog must find 2 hides); Birch and/or Anise and/or Clove may be utilized in Excellent (dog must find 3 hides); Birch and/or Anise and/or Clove and/or Cypress in Master (dog must find 1 to 3 hides, exhibitor will not know how many hides there are).

AKC registered dogs 6 months of age and over may compete in Scent Work. Females in estrus cannot compete. Of note is that deaf, blind and amputees can compete as long as the dog can participate without discomfort or stress and do so in a safe manner. Positive reinforcements (generally food or a toy) are allowed in the search area after the alert is given and the judge acknowledges a correct find. Praise is allowed during the search although most handlers are quiet to better focus on the dog's behavior and body language.

Handler Discrimination is another division of Scent Work which utilizes the handler's scent as the identifying hide. Titling levels are Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master and the dogs seem to enjoy finding their owners scent.

This article's purpose is to be an introduction to AKC Scent Work and to whet your appetite to learn more. A more detailed article description can be found on the AKC website. Many training clubs are now offering beginner and introduction to Scent Work classes to their schedules to help dogs and handlers get ready for the new titles.

Bullmastiff owners are encouraged to explore this exciting new venue. Scent Work not only builds trust but cements the bond between a dog and owner team and allows the dog to continue to do what comes naturally, from the day they were born. You can do this and both you and your dog will have fun as you do!

CANINE INFLUENZA

What is Canine Influenza

The Influenza A virus is a highly contagious single-stranded RNA virus first isolated in 1933. Due to its ability to mutate, there are many strains and subtypes. Avians are considered the natural host and reservoir for all subtypes of influenza A, but other species can become a primary host.

Two types of influenza A have been identified in dogs in the United States. The 2004 outbreak in racing greyhounds in Florida was the H3N8 strain. This strain was thought to have started in horses then adapted to dogs. Since then, H3N8 shows up sporadically and has been seen in most US states. In March of 2015 a milder strain, H3N2, was detected in Chicago. This strain is closely related to an Asian avian strain identified in 2006. In 2016 shelter cats had also been reported to be infected with this strain. To date, human cases have not been identified.

More recently the H3N2 strain has been in the news. In March, 2017 there was an outbreak of H3N2 in Los Angeles shelters. Prior to that outbreak dogs had been imported from Asia by a rescue group. Then in May 2017, it appeared again in Florida and has since spread to multiple other states. The most recent documentation I found showed 30 US states have reported it.

The influenza virus infects and replicates within cells of the respiratory tract, from the nasal lining to terminal airways. Inflammation of these tissues results in the respiratory clinical signs. Death of the epithelial cells lining the respiratory tract can lead to secondary bacterial infections and further complications of the disease.

Because canine influenza is not a widespread disease, most dogs have no immunity to it. Morbidity (those that are exposed that contract the disease) is approximately 80%. The remaining 20% can still be carriers and shed the virus. Mortality (death rate) is less than 10%.

Clinical Signs

Clinical signs, for both strains, are very similar to infectious tracheobronchitis (bordetella bronchiseptica/parainfluenza virus complex) or Kennel Cough. This presents as acute onset of respiratory signs: rhinitis, tracheitis, and bronchitis. The majority of cases are a mild form with a persistent cough (ten to thirty days) despite treatment. The cough is either dry or soft and moist. There may be nasal and/or ocular discharge, sneezing, lethargy, and anorexia (lack of appetite.) Secondary bacterial infection can lead to purulent (puss) nasal discharge and fever. Canine influenza can turn more serious when a secondary bacterial infection turns into pneumonia. There is usually a high-grade fever (104-106) with an increased respiratory rate and effort. With treatment, most recover in two to four weeks.

Transmission

Canine influenza spreads easily between individuals but usually involves direct contact with bodily fluids of an infected dog (saliva and oro-nasal secretions.) Other modes of transmission include droplets or aerosolization from coughing, sneezing, and barking or fomites (objects or people that carry the virus from an infected dog.) The virus can remain viable for up to forty eight hours on hard surfaces, on clothing twenty four hours, and hands twelve hours. This demonstrates the importance of washing tables, bowls, equipment, hands and clothes after potential exposure, especially noting that dogs can be carriers and an infected dog can shed the virus before showing signs of illness. The virus is easily killed by disinfectants used in veterinary hospitals and boarding facilities and shelters. A 10% bleach solution will be effective on appropriate surfaces.

The incubation period (exposure to clinical signs) for H3N8 is between one to five days and two to eight days for H3N2. The most contagious period is during the incubation period and dogs can shed the virus when not showing clinical signs.

Diagnosis

If your dog has been in a region influenza has been reported and is showing signs of respiratory illness, consider it influenza until proven otherwise. Your veterinarian will appreciate notification of your suspicions prior to arrival so precautions can be taken to prevent exposure to others.

There are tests available to diagnose influenza A in general and specifically for H3N8 and H3N2 strains. Testing for viral shedding (immunoassays to detect antigen/ELISA, PCR to detect virus nucleic acid, and virus isolation) must be done early in the disease because of early and brief shedding of the virus. H3N8 virus may shed for only 1 week, while H3N2 may shed longer, but peak viral shedding occurs early in infection (two to three days of clinical illness).

Ideal specimens for PCR testing are nasal and deep pharyngeal swabs. Turnaround time for results is typically one to three working days. Positive results are considered confirmatory in a patient with compatible clinical signs.

Serology testing for antibodies in the blood is more effective later in the disease but only tests for specific strains. Positive results occur with exposure, infection or vaccine. False negative results are possible early in an infection, so paired acute and convalescent titers are recommended. A rising titer is consistent with infection. This test is most useful in patients with chronic clinical illness that are less likely to be shedding virus for detection by PCR.

Treatment

Treatments will vary with the severity of illness but are largely supportive. Mild cases may involve fluids and cough suppressants. More serious cases may require chest radiographs, antibiotics, antipyretics (to reduce fever), and hospitalization. Antiviral medications (Tamiflu/oseltamivir) are not approved for use in dogs. Their use is controversial because it is not known if they are effective in dogs, but may be used extra label. Most dogs will have recovered by 4 weeks but should remain isolated from other dogs for that entire time frame.

Preventions

Vaccination for canine influenza is based on risk assessment: exposure to other dogs (showing/competing, dog parks, training in groups) and prevalence in the area. There is no cross protection between the two strains but there are vaccines available for each strain, as well as a bivalent vaccine that includes both. They are killed vaccines so will not replicate or shed the virus. The vaccine does not completely eliminate the risk of infection but reduces the severity and duration of the disease. A three-week booster is req=uired and you should wait three to four weeks after that before taking your dog to a high-risk environment.

Rigorous isolation and sanitation protocols should be followed for dogs showing clinical signs. Dogs with known exposure to canine influenza should not be brought to facilities other dogs will be present for three to four weeks.

Veterinarian and ABA member Sandra Statter Irwin's mother always told her she could have as many animals as she wanted, when she grew up. She got her DVM and her first Bullmastiff in 1994 and has since been involved in agility and conformation with her dogs, breeding Bullmastiffs under the Showdown prefix.

BLADDER CANCER IN DOGS

Cancer of the urinary tract in dogs can affect any one of the components of the urinary system. This includes: kidneys, ureters, bladder, prostate or urethra. The bladder is the most common site affected. When compared to other cancers that can affect dogs, bladder cancer is relatively rare and occurs in about 1 - 2% of dogs. Females are more inclined to get bladder cancer as opposed to males due to their anatomy. This may be partly due to the fact that females do not mark as often as males and any toxins in the bladder are not as readily eliminated. The most common cancer of the bladder is known as transitional cell carcinoma or TCC.

TCC is a malignant tumor that develops from the transitional epithelial cells that line the bladder. This may lead to local lymph node involvement which can lead to metastasis or transfer to other parts of the body. TCC can occur in other urinary structures but by far the bladder is the most common. It is an intermediate to high grade tumor.

CAUSES:

The exact cause is usually unknown however there can be a genetic predisposition and environmental factors. Genetically, breeds at risk include but are not limited to: Scottish Terriers, West Highland White Terriers, Beagles, Shelties, and Wire Haired Fox Terriers.

Environmental risk factors include exposure to pesticides and insecticides. Obesity is another possible cause.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS:

Blood in the urine, straining, dribbling etc. can be an early indicator of TCC but can also be common symptoms of a urinary tract infection. It can also indicate urinary stones or other growths in the urinary system. How do you differentiate?

In the case of a urinary tract infection a urine culture can identify an organism and antibiotic therapy is indicated. X-rays and ultrasounds can determine presence of stones or other growths. If these prove to be negative, TCC may be suspected.

DIAGNOSIS:

Most often, a tissue biopsy is indicated. Ultrasounds performed by a skilled radiologist can also indicate TCC although without a biopsy it cannot be proven. Biopsies are obtained through a cystoscopy (insertion of a fiber optic scope into the bladder and biopsy through the scope). It is important to note that a mass located in the neck of the bladder is often all that is needed to make the diagnosis of TCC.

TUMOR STAGING:

Tumor staging is the process of looking for the presence of tumor in other areas of the body. Staging can provide some information regarding prognosis and establish a baseline to determine if treatment is effective. Abdominal ultrasounds and chest radiographs can locate distant metastasis or spread of the disease.

TREATMENT:

Surgery is an option but much depends on the location of the tumor. If the tumor is located in the "trigone" area (the neck of the bladder and the urethra) surgery is not an option. Radiation is another option but again, it can lead to harmful complications such as a scarred bladder and irritation to the surrounding tissues.

Medical treatment is the best option. Two broad categories of drugs have been used to treat TCC. Traditional chemotherapy can be used but the response is disappointing and carries with it many unwanted side effects. The use of NSAIDS (non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs) is a widely used protocol. NSAIDS block the cyclo-oxygenese (cox enzyme) and are referred to as "cox inhibitors".

Cox inhibitors include pyroxicam, Deramaxx, Rimadyl and others. The most commonly used is pyroxicam (used in humans and known as Feldene). The use of NSAIDS developed due to the fact that these drugs were used as pain relievers in canines affected with cancer. It was noted that many dogs developed "stable disease" and a few actually went into remission.

PROGNOSIS:

It is not known how long dogs with TCC that are not treated will survive. Survival is affected by the growth rate of the tumor, the location of the tumor, and whether the tumor has spread to other organs. The median survival for dogs treated with chemotherapy and or NSAIDS (or combination of both) varied from 130 to 190 days. These survival times vary tremendously, ranging from only a few days to over one year.

SYMPTOMATIC CARE:

Dogs with TCC are very prone to developing bacterial infections in the bladder. Frequent urinalysis, cultures and antibiotic treatment may be necessary.

FOLLOW-UP:

Dogs on any medication regime must have periodic blood samples taken, particularly liver values. A CBC (complete blood count) is also recommended. TCC can block the flow of urine into and out of the bladder. Complete obstruction can rapidly lead to life-threatening complications. Although there are procedures that can be performed to alleviate this complication, it does impact the quality of life.

CONCLUSION:

Ultimately, this is a fatal disease. The important thing to keep in mind is your dog's quality of life. This brief description of TCC is by no means conclusive. There are many treatment options not listed but in the end, it is the comfort of the dog that matters.

On a personal note:

On May 20, 2015, we lost a very precious boy. Watson was diagnosed with TCC on December 31, 2014 and not 6 months later he had succumbed to the disease. I can't stress enough to know your dogs "normal" habits. We all know that when a bullmastiff doesn't want to eat, something is wrong. If they are normally active and happy, and become sullen and withdrawn, something is wrong. How many of you know your dog's bowel and particularly their bladder habits???

Watson's cancer was insidious. I noticed several months before his diagnosis something I hadn't seen before. After having a bowel movement and as he was getting up from squatting, he forcibly urinated. It happened just a few times and went away. Then about one month before his diagnosis, it started again. I thought it was a urinary tract infection and so I brought him in and a routine urinalysis was performed. Although it showed no bacteria, he was put on a course of antibiotics. I did not see any noticeable change in his bladder habits. After completing the antibiotics he had a sterile specimen obtained and it too showed no bacteria. This was followed by an x-ray of his bladder and prostate which proved negative. I took him in to a specialist and upon ultrasound, there it was, TCC. At this point he had no tumor metastasis in any other organ or lymph nodes. The tumor was very small. Because of its' location, surgery and radiation was not an option. He was put on an NSAID (pyroxicam) and no more. Chemotherapy may have bought him an extra month but at what cost? We chose to let him live his remaining time as he saw fit. We knew he would let us know when it was time and as usual, Watson did not let us down. He died peacefully surrounded by family and friends, his tail wagging to the end.

AROUND THE RINGS...

A timely piece with the ABA National Specialty just around the corner..." Thank the Show Chair"

He got home really late last night. It was almost midnight and from what he was muttering nearly under his breath, it sounded as though his last-minute check of the show site uncovered a major issue with the layout of the breed rings, a problem with the vender booth spaces assigned, and the oversight that the trophy tables were still nowhere to be found. He got everything sorted out, but was running behind, with lots still left to do. I had to tell him about the frantic phone calls from two judges who were delayed by severe weather and cancelled flights and unsure whether they would arrive in time to judge in the morning. I also relayed the bad news that nobody could lay hands on the ancient audio tape of The Star-Spangled Banner we usually used to open the show. The worse news was that one of our show committee members has a niece who is supposedly very talented and she wanted her to sing the National Anthem. We sat down to discuss these problems and to go over the rest of the last-minute show checklist. A little later, while putting together the ring stewards' bags, we realized that we had no more hand sanitizer, so he headed out to the grocery store for that one last thing. Again. My cell phone rang soon after he left and the chief ring steward's husband was on the phone disjointedly informing me that our fellow volunteer was being admitted to the hospital with pancreatitis. I tried to be appropriately sympathetic, but all I could think about was the fact that tomorrow, at eight o'clock in the morning, nobody would be organizing the ring stewards. Nobody but my husband, the Show Chair. Another sleepless night for him. Another show weekend about to happen. What next? Please, thank the Show Chair.

We all love a dog show! That is something that brings so many of us in the dog world together. Win or lose, amateurs or professionals, this sport sparks something within us. Whatever it is, it keeps us competing, out of love for our dogs and because of our desire to come together with others who share our passion. Whether we look forward to competing in agility or obedience or rally or to presenting our dogs in the conformation ring, we peruse the premium lists that arrive in our mailboxes with anticipation, noting the judging panels listed, the hotel and RV accommodations highlighted, the health clinics offered, the handling seminars scheduled, and all of the other unique activities and novel events that the show committees have planned for every show weekend. I think that most of us also note specialties planned, trophies offered, new events demonstrated, and evening entertainments arranged. We look to dog shows to educate us and to entertain us, even as we count on them to bring us together with friends. Of course, we come to exhibit our dogs to our peers in the fancy and to earn points and titles, but the shows are so much more than competitions. Every premium list promises something different, whether it announces a new cluster of clubs coming together at a different location or advertises an annual favorite show weekend where everyone camps together and potluck dinners occur every night. We love these weekends, don't we? Where else could we so celebrate our dogs? Please, thank the Show Chair.

Behind the scenes of these weekends filled with accomplishments and enjoyment, the Show Committee, usually a core group far smaller than one might imagine, works together to make sure that everything that is planned happens, to solve all of the problems that occur (and there will be problems), and to provide positive experiences for all of us participating in the sport of purebred dogs.

Kennel clubs across the country, as well as regional and National breed clubs, host shows at least annually and nearly all of the work involved in putting on the shows is done by volunteers. It is amazing, when you think about it, that these people are willing to give so much of their talent and time to the clubs and to the shows. By day, these people might be in sales or finance, might sell cars or practice medicine, could be retired or currently running a company, but in their spare time, they are the show committee, in charge of catering, facilities, judges, stewards, trophies, vendors, and every aspect of the weekends. They are involved in the sport, as we are, and they are the people who make it happen for the rest of us, weekend after weekend, year after year. Still, at the end of the weekend, the Show Chair and other members of the show committee feel a sense of accomplishment and their thanks is another successful dog show, something they love as much as we all do. Maybe you are willing to volunteer for the next show, even step up and serve as Show Chair? Think about it. You can let me know later. Please, thank the Show Chair.

When we attend a show, it might seem as though everything is going smoothly, as though no issues are occurring, and like it is happening with ease all around us. There is usually an exciting and festive atmosphere and the site is filled with beautiful dogs of every breed. For those of us who love dog shows, all is right with the world. That is not usually the case. When there are people coming together in competition, there will be drama and we can only hope that there is more comedy than tragedy. Whatever happens, the Show Chair is "where the buck stops." He has to be able to rely on his committee, because, as we all know, the show must go on! Look around for the members of the show committee and their behavior will offer a sense of how the show is really going. They will be the ones in motion, searching for misplaced rosettes, looking for a late judge, administering first aid to a fallen toddler, or cleaning up a dog's accident. While dogs are being shown, the show committee is rarely at rest, and that applies especially to the Show Chair. Anything can go wrong and, if the committee is lucky, so much will also go right. One exhibitor might not be taking adequate care of dogs crated at the show site, while another may be complaining about biased judging, and yet another could be finding fault with the small ring size or the photographer's backdrop. the Language of Dogs Primal Instincts 101



Each breed of dog was created with a purpose. From our breed's guardian instinct to the bloodhound's ability to sniff and track, breeders have for generations molded and shaped breeds to exhibit certain traits and have culled from programs those dogs who do not. However, other things have been carried down on those genes as well. One of them is the communication method dogs use, the language of dogs.

The dog as we know it was originally a wild animal. They lived in groups, as they still do today. The vast majority of a dog's communication is done nonverbally. Body language is the primary mode of communication, with verbalization used mostly for extremes. Alarms, warnings, threats, extreme happiness, and anxieties are often noted verbally and once we hear the verbalization for these responses, several modes of nonverbal communication have most likely taken place. It is up to us to understand their language.

Most behavioral issues are unknowingly and unintentionally exacerbated by our misinterpretation and misuse of our own daily routines and bodies. What means one thing to a human can mean the total opposite to the dog. To make matters more confusing, not every body language rule applies to every dog. Because they have not needed these communication skills in order to survive with us, some of them have fallen by the wayside. Some dogs will bury a bone outside or in bedding. Some dogs will circle every time before they lie down. These are manifestations of primal instinct once used for survival and now a vestigial remnant. When trying to mold a new puppy, or modify some undesirable behaviors, it is important to be aware of the messages you may be sending unintentionally. Let's start with one we are all guilty of from time to time: petting a puppy or small dog improperly and triggering a domination instinct.

For this example, let's assume we are out and socializing a five-month old pup. Your dog is comfortable on leash and has met strangers in the comfort of his home with no issue. Now we are at a busy park and the puppy's spirits are high and everyone is having a good time.

Several people come over and ask if they may pet your dog and you agree. As time goes on you notice your puppy is not walking forward to greet people anymore; he starting to hang back a bit. He is still wagging his tail when people pet him, but he is just not that into it anymore. Most assume puppy is tired and has had enough for the day. That very well could be the case. However, let's think about how most people pet a smaller dog or puppy. They bend over and pet it, talk goofy to it, and some will even try to give a kiss or ask for one from the dog. For a lot of dogs that is no harm, no foul. However, on occasion you will have a dog who is sensitive to being dominated by another creature looming above. If your puppy is feeling the high energy and happiness of everyone around him, yet something deep inside feels threatened, he can become confused. Some dogs read our body language of towering over them, bending over them, putting our faces in theirs, as a direct challenge. They eventually no longer enjoy the stranger interactions and manifest it through fearfulness or aggressive tendencies. Some dogs will just go belly up as soon as they see a new person and there may be a little submissive urination. If the dog's initial reactions are not read correctly, he cannot be guided through the inappropriate response he is having within his own mind. It becomes the way of the world to the dog. He learns that strangers will always dominate and challenge him. He decides he doesn't like it. End of life lesson.

If we are aware of a dog's potential primal instinct to dominate by looming over one another, then we can watch for the misinterpretation by the dog. If the dog is indeed reactive, then he can have stranger interactions happen from the side, with the person kneeling down, where there is no looming, where there is no face-to-face confrontation. As stated before, not every dog will react this way. Even dogs who are very pushy and dominant towards other dogs may not read the human actions as a negative. Every dog is different and we, as stewards of a guardian breed, must be hyper aware. The fight or flight response can be triggered with high or low intensity. If your dog is sending out signal after signal, communication after communication, to no avail, he will attempt vocal communication, possibly accompanied by action.

There is always a reason why a dog acts the way he does. Genetics play a large part in molding who your dog is, but our interpretation of the dog's instincts plays just as much of a role as these animals attempt to navigate our world. Every time your dog gets in to a car with you, he has no idea where he is going. It could be five blocks or five hundred miles. He gets in because he trusts you. In order to have trust in every situation, communicating effectively is paramount.
