#### Best Owner-Handled in Show Competition National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country. All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handler eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.** 

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

#### AKC Sanctioned 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of **Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in each Breed/Variety**. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth Placements.

The Miscellaneous class competition will be judged same as above followed by a Miscellaneous 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. The Foundation Stock Service CLass Competition will be judged same as above followed by a FSS 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Group Competition. All First Place Group Winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will br required for entries of an AKC recognized breed or Miscellaneous breed. FSS number of FSS registered litter number will be required for FSS entries.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of orgin.

Dogs must be four months of age and under six months. Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' oprganization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for th judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 month Puppy Special Attraction event.

Sweepstakes entries must be handled by the owner, co-owner, a member of the owner's or co-owner's family, breeder or an ama-teurhandler. Professional handlers, as defined by the Association, are per-mitted to handle sweepstakes entries only if they are the owner, co-owner, a member of the owner's family or the breeder of the sweepstakes entry. Dogs shownin Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes. Entries shall be made at the same time & on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family or by an amateur handler with the exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense, and all prize money is the property of the owner. Dogs shown in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in one of the regular classes at this show. Entries shall be made on the same entry form Regular Classes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division in space provided. Winners of the Veteran Sweepstakes classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

#### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

#### Judge's Award of Merit

Immediately following the Best of Breed Competition, Awards of Merit may be awarded to those dogs or bitches not winning Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Best of Winners or Select Dog and Select Bitch, but are deemed of such outstanding quality as to deserve recognition. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, and Select Bitch may not be considered by virtue of their already higher placement. The maximum number of such awards of merit shall be limited to 10% of the total entry in Best of Breed, up to a maximum of 12. (The percentage will be rounded up.)

#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

BEST OF BREED - The Best of Breed competition entries will be brought into the show ring in its entirety to check armbands and then will be judged in groups.

BEST BRINDLE IN SHOW- Best Brindle, an intersex class to be judged after Best of Breed, is open to all Brindles previously undefeated by another Brindle in a class during the judging of the regular or non-regular classes that lead to and include Best of Breed. This includes Veterans, but NOT Sweepstakes, Futurity, or any class where an award depends on more than one dog for placement.

Guidelines for choosing Best Brindle:

1. If the Best of Breed winner is eligible it will also be awarded Best Brindle.

2. If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Best Brindle.

3. If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible for the Best Brindle competition and both the Select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Best Brindle from the Selects, and if eligible, Winners Dog and/or Winners Bitch. If either Winners Dog or Winners bitch is not eligible, any class dog of that sex that was undefeated by a brindle will be included.

4. If one of the Selects is eligible for Best Brindle competition, excuse all eligible champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Brindle from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners. If the Winners dog or bitch is not eligible, any unbeaten class dogs of that sex will be included. If one of the Awards of Merit is eligible for Best Brindle. - and Best of Breed. Best of

Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Selects are not eligible - then the highest placing eligible Award of Merit competes against any eligible class dogs unbeaten by a Brindle for Best Brindle.

5. If the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch and all Awards of Merit are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. If the Winners Dog or the Winners Bitch are not eligible, then any unbeaten Brindle class dog of that sex will compete against any remaining dogs.

**BEST PUPPY IN PUPPY CLASS** - First Place Winners in each regular puppy class will compete for Best Puppy after Best of Breed judging. Only entries in Puppy 6-9 month or 9-12 months are eligible.

Guidelines for choosing Best Puppy:

- A puppy winning Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best Puppy.
- A puppy awarded Best of Winners defeats all other puppies of both sexes.
- A puppy awarded Best of Opposite Sex or Winners defeats all other puppies in that sex.
- A puppy awarded Reserve Winners defeats all other puppies in that sex if another puppy has not been awarded Winners.
- A puppy selected for an Award of Merit defeats all other puppies not previously selected for a higher-level award.

**BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS** -The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; not Champions of Record on the date of closing of entries for the show; individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR IN BBE CLASS - The Bred-By-Exhibitor class winner in each sex will compete for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor after Best of Breed judging. A BBE awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best BBE. A BBE awarded an Award of Merit defeats any BBE not selected for a higher-level award. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

BEST VETERAN - First Place winners in each regular veteran class will compete for Best Veteran after Best of Breed Judging. Awards of Merit (respective of placement) defeat all other veterans of that sex. A veteran winning Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best Veteran. A veteran winning Best of Opposite Sex defeats all veterans of that sex. A veteran winning Best of Breed is automatically awarded Best Veteran.

AWARDS OF MERIT - Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Selects are NOT to be considered for Award of Merit. Judges will select Awards of Merit in order of preference from all other dogs competing in Best of Breed.

#### Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Only)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class & must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be an owner of the Get. Award only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Each of the Get must be entered in a regular class. Stud dog does NOT have to be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Notes to Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes:

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry awarded First Place in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS - This Class shall be for two dogs, (a Unit), of the same breed irrespective of sex, belonging to one or more common owner. Dogs entered in each Brace Class Unit must each also be entered in another regular class. Show Brace Class in "Additional Class" portion of the entry form. If more than once Brace is entered by one or more common owner(s), the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated Brace # 1, Brace #2, etc.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- **NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.
- **OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.
- MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to entry the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

#### FUTURITY

#### NO ENTRY FEE

Futurity is an event held in conjunction with the National Specialty. It is similar to a puppy sweepstakes except the nomination process is open only to breeders and co-breeders, all of which must be members in good standing with the American Bullmastiff Association (ABA). The Futurity puppy owner(s) and/or co-owner(s) must also be members in good standing with the ABA by the date of the applicable National Specialty OR be published applicants for membership in the ABA Newsletter prior to the sixth month birthday of the nominated puppy. Futurity entries must be handled by the owner, co-owner, a member of the owner or co-owner's family, the breeder, or an amateur handler. Professional handlers, as defined by the Association, are permitted to handle Futurity entries only if they are the owner/co-owner, or the breeder/co-breeder of the Futurity entry provided they are also an ABA member in good standing.

Futurity involves a series of nominations prior to the date on which the Futurity is held. Bitches that have been bred are first nominated at a fee set by the ABA, **prior to the whelping**. After the puppies are born, one or more puppies of the nominated litter may be nominated at Less Than 3 Months and Less Than 6 Months of age. **The only dogs eligible for entry in Futurity are those whose nominations have been kept current in accordance with the ABA Standing Rules for Futurity, effective March 1st, 2020.** A litter could have been nominated if it was whelped on or after March 1, 2020 and on or before February 28, 2021.

Breeders of Futurity nominated dogs are responsible for informing their owners on the correct entry procedures for the Futurity competition. The Futurity Chair or Show Secretary will not be held responsible for incorrectly entered Futurity dogs and will remain indifferent and impartial to any differences over winnings between breeder and/or co-breeder (s). NOTE: ABA National Specialty dates are subject to change. In the event that a litter is eligible for two (2) National Futurity entries (current year and/or following year), the breeder of the litter must select which National Specialty they would like to enter on the Litter Nomination Form at the time of submission. All decisions are final. The litter will only be eligible for one (1) Futurity entry at a National Specialty. If a puppy is past its' 18-month birthday at a National Specialty due to the National Specialty being held later in the fall, that puppy will still be eligible for Futurity competition and will be entered in the 18 month and over class as specified in the Premium List.

The Futurity class is considered a second entry in addition to a regular class for the National Specialty. Under the "additional class" section of the entry form, enter "Futurity: along with the proper age category. A **dog/bitch may not be shown in Futurity without entry in a Regular Class**. The entry fee for Futurity is paid from Futurity funds, so no fee is required from the breeder/owner to the Show Secretary for this Additional Class.

#### CLASSIFICATION

 The winners from these classes will then compete for Best Dog in Futurity & Best Bitch in Futurity

#### DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

The Futurity funds will be split as follows: Forty-five percent (45%) will be divided equally among the (10) ten first place winners in each age group. Twenty (20%) will be given to both the Best Bitch in Futurity and Best Dog in Futurity. Fifteen percent (15%) will be retained by the ABA to cover reasonable Futurity expenses including those incurred from Show Secretary and/or administrative fees. Given the unusual occasion that the 15% holdback from the accumulated annual Futurity funds is not adequate to cover "reasonable expenses" directly associated with the Futurity, the Board may approve an additional amount to be withheld. The additional amount would be withdrawn from the accumulated annual futurity. If there is no entry in a class, then those funds shall be allocated pro rata amongst the remaining classes and to Best Bitch in Futurity and Best Dog in Futurity. These funds will not be allocated to the ABA holdback. All winnings go to the breeder and/or co-breeder of record.

#### MATURITY

A class to be judged on consistency of type in three generation of dogs. Dogs must be entered in a regular class on the regular entry form. All dogs must be identified at the time of entry. Class will not be divided by sex. A bitch or dog must be shown with a son or daughter & grandson or granddaughter. (One dog per generation for the total of three dogs shown oldest to youngest.) The grandson or granddaughter need not be the offspring of the son or daughter. The Maturity is judged much like the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Classes, except that the merits of all three generations are

considered. Entries must be made on the following form.

#### TRIATHLON RULES

The Triathlon will be comprised of competition in three (3) areas.

- 1) Standard Agility (Regular or Preferred Jump Heights)
- 2) Obedience and/or Rally Obedience
- 3) Conformation

Dogs must be entered in regular classes for Obedience, Rally Obedience, and either Regular or Preferred Agility. Preferred, Graduate or Beginner Novice obedience classes will not be included in calculations for the Triathlon even if offered. Dogs may compete for all levels they are eligible for and additional points will be awarded for upper level classes.

Dogs that achieve a qualifying score in obedience, rally and agility will receive 10 bonus points for each "Q". Teams participating in the Triathlon may choose to compete in Obedience and/or Rally Obedience . Scores will be adjusted to allow for the significant difference in level of skills and difficulty required between Obedience and Rally Obedience. For teams competing in both Obedience and Rally, the highest score earned will be counted. The same team of dog and handler must compete all three phases of the competition with no exceptions. The handlers must be a registered owner of the dog or a member of the immediate family of the owner of the dog.

#### CONFORMATION

Dogs will be judged according to the official AKC standard with the exception that spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Triathlon competition. A judge will be appointed by the National Show Committee with the approval of the ABA Board. A total of 100 possible points may be awarded by the judge with dogs to be scored and placed according to the points earned. Each dog will be judged separately by the Triathlon conformation judge according to the official AKC Standard. The scores will be recorded by the judge in the Triathlon conformation score card that is provided. Any dog disqualified by the judge will receive no score.

#### OBEDIENCE

Novice: Qualifying score divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet and divided by 2)

Open: Qualifying score + 15 divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet +15 and divid-ed by 2)

Utility: Qualifying score + 30 divided by 2 (if NQ actual points earned from official judges score sheet +30 and divid-ed by 2)

For dogs competing in both Open and Utility or Novice and Open, the highest score earned will be used. If the dog has NQ'd in both Open and Utility or Novice and Open the highest score shall be used.

#### RALLŸ

Novice: Score multiplied by .4

Intermediate: Score multiplied by .425

Advanced: Score multiplied by .55

Excellent: Score multiplied by .65

Master: Score multiplied by .85

For Dogs competing in Advanced, Excellent and/or Master only the highest score earned will be used. **AGILITY** (Standard or Preferred jump heights)

Novice: Score

Open: Score +10

Excellent/Master: Score +20

(F) Failure = 10 points

(R) Refusuals/run outs = 5 points

(W) Wrong course = 5 points

(E) Excusal = No score (eliminating in ring, leaving ring, judge determines dog is out of control course not complete.

Time Faults = 1 point per second

There is a significant difference in difficulty between Rally and Obedience competition. Rally does not require the same skills as Obedience (i.e. in Rally handlers may talk/encourage/praise dogs, give multiple commands, retry exercises and complete only a short sit/stay upon command. In obedience, dogs work without multiple commands, without encouragement/praise during exercises, exercised cannot be retried, dogs complete much longer sits off lead). So while a choice is given to compete in Rally or Obedience for the Triathlon scores must be adjusted to reflect the difficulty for each.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management (including extreme weather) it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

#### CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

Effective May 1, 2006, an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
